Project Summary

SOFWERX, in collaboration with United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), Special Operations Forces Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics (SOF AT&L), partnered with the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense Test Resource Management Center (OUSD TRMC) to provide a powerful capability for non-invasively analyzing a global range of Open-Source Intelligence. This capability leveraged Natural Language Processing, machine learning, statistical analysis, and subject matter expertise to process data from social media, Resource Description Framework Site Summary (RSS) feeds, sensors, and other structured, semi-structured, and unstructured data sources, enabling the detection of faint signals and the identification of potential threat areas.

Utilizing artificial intelligence and machine learning (AI/ML)-powered data analytics technologies, ALQIMI analyzed millions of PAI and CAI-derived sources to identify potential exposure of U.S. test and evaluation events.
